## Promenade, Beach and Couple

No visit to Newbiggin by the Sea is complete without a refreshing walk along the promenade or along our recently restored beach - courtesy of half a million tons of sand from the sea-bed off Skeppes!

In the bay stands *Googie* (affectionately called *Eb and Flo* by the local folk) the UK's first permanent offshore artwork. A miniature version of *Couple* can also be viewed on the promenade near to the Lifeboat Station.

## Lifeboat Station & Boatyard

Opened in 1851, the Lifeboat Station is the oldest operational boathouse in the UK. Knowledgeable guides will explain the vital role the lifeboat has played in the village's history.
